We are seeking a highly skilled and motivated team player to serve as the Head of Research. The ideal candidate should have an extensive understanding of research frameworks, policy analysis, project management and human resource management. This individual will play a key role in directing the Centre's security and strategic studies priorities in the Eastern Africa region.

- Direct in-depth research and analysis on security and strategic studies trends, challenges, and best practices in East Africa and globally.
- Support the design and implementation of security and strategic studies-related programs and projects.
- Initiate and cultivate beneficial partnerships in the research eco-system regionally and internationally.
- Write reports, policy briefs, and other publications for diverse stakeholders, including policymakers, donors, and the public.
- Facilitate workshops, training sessions, and policy dialogues to in pursuit of a secure and prosperous Eastern Africa region.
- Monitor and evaluate security and strategic studies and research projects, ensuring alignment with best practices and sustainable outcomes.
- Identify relevant funding frameworks, lead and initiate funding proposals to support security and strategic studies research at the Centre.
- Mentor early career researchers by creating structures to support the pipeline of next generation researchers and policy analysts.
- Serve as the Managing Editor of the Mashariki Security Journal.
- Line manage the Associate Research Fellows of the Centre.

Qualifications:

Education: Doctoral degree in Peace and Security Studies, Security and Governance, Political Science, Public Administration, International Relations, Law, or related fields from a recognized institution.

Experience:

At least 5 years of experience in research/academia with a strong track record in policy analysis around security and strategic studies, Experience working with governments, international organizations, NGOs, or think tanks in Eastern Africa is highly desirable.
